

TASAH Mandate

Trinity Against Sexual Assault and Harassment (TASAH) aims to:

1. Facilitate and liaise with the CAC and administration to create a sexual assault information packet that includes a definition of sexual violence, a report procedure for victims of sexual assault, a list of people on campus trained to respond to reports of sexual violence, resources available to victims, and procedures for investigation of reports. For following years, an assessment of existing policies, protocols and practices regarding sexual assault and harassment will be an annual endeavor.

Note: Trinity College follows the University of Toronto's sexual assault policy. The purpose of the document TASAH will be putting forward is not to overrule the University-wide policy, but to provide a written guide for (1) what a victim can expect from the administration, Dons, and student leaders, (2) a written explanation of a victim's options within Trinity, the University of Toronto, and Toronto-wide following an assault, and (3) what a victim's rights are on campus.

2. Ensure a strong presence within the College community through sex-positive awareness campaigns and educational sessions surrounding sexual and domestic violence, with means to educate the Trinity College community. TASAH will hold multiple events throughout each semester to uphold this goal. These events could include workshops, outside speakers and social events.

We are currently planning an events such as a Teen Dating Abuse seminar in February, the TASAH St. Patrick's Day party, and a training session for club executives- which will be open to students, and a SEC run rights information session.

3. Create a safer space in the Trinity community with regards to sexual violence.
4. Ensure that the SCC funded *Supporting Sexual Assault Survivors at Trinity* fund is used and maintained

The club's executive structure for the 2019-2020 academic year hopes to include a president, a treasurer, a communications representative, an events coordinator, and three members at large.
